- **Local Plan consultation closing soon**

This is the last week for comments on the Local Plan review 'Issues and Options' consultation, which closes at 5pm on Friday 30 November 2018. Three drop-in sessions have taken place and the main issues raised included the need for more smaller, affordable homes and bungalows, the impact of new development on existing and future local services and facilities, and how best to protect sensitive and important areas of the natural environment, including wildlife. - **Reminder - relocation of County Council data centre**

The Staffordshire County Council's secondary data centre is in the process of relocating and there is a potential risk of disruption to our internet service this weekend commencing Friday 23 November 2018 from 5pm. The work is scheduled to run throughout the weekend and they hope any unintended disruptions will be resolved over the weekend although there is a risk that disruption may occur early next week too.

- **#OurDay trends at number 1**

Thank you to all staff who took part in this year's #OurDay on Tuesday, the annual social media day organised by the LGA that takes a look at a day in the life of local government. More than 10,000 different contributors took part including South Staffordshire Council and a collective 33,558 tweets were sent during the day. Our combined efforts saw local government trending at number one in the UK all day and peaking at number four worldwide.
