- The grass matting around some of the gym equipment is sinking into the mud. This will require some remedial work when the weather is a little better.
- Police response from meeting held on 9th March 2020
 - Special constable Wilding has been asked by PCSO Fryer to patrol the area when possible and he can ticket if necessary.
 - PCSO recruitment - Perton/Pattingham/Codsall/Bilbrook (locality 4) will have one new PCSO from the current intake at the end of March, they will be mentored by PCSO Fryer. We will hopefully get more from the next intake.
 - PCSO Fryer thanked the Parish Council for the purchase of 25 door/window alarms which will be given to Perton residents free of charge when the Crime prevention bus visits Perton on 5th April. **19/03/20 Unfortunately this event is now cancelled, alarms have not been purchased.**
- Ash Waste – A review of service charge has increased collection by £1.93 per lift.
- Civic Centre closed to the public from 23rd March 2020 due to COVID-19.
- PPC removed life belt from the basketball hoop in MUGA. SSDC have replaced.
- Best Kept Village Competition 2020 is postponed, with a view to reviewing it later in the year
- PPC reported fallen fence on pathway at the side of the Library ref: 4196430
- The Road Safety Grant Fund is currently under review and we they are hoping to launch a new scheme later this year. Further information will be available on their website in due course.
- Perton Parish Council and Civic Centre staff working from home where possible.
- All Parish Council meetings including scheduled committee meetings for April are cancelled. Council to review this for future meetings when legislation and guideline are known from NALC.
- Pre-application for MUGA lighting states, Under Part 12 of The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 2015 the Local Authorities is permitted to install lighting to the MUGA as long as it does not exceed 4m in height, the proposal would be classed as permitted development and planning permission would not need to be obtained.
- The Parish Council in conjunction with The Church At Perton have set up the Perton Community Support Hub to help the isolated and vulnerable residents. We currently have 19 volunteers and 18 residents that need support.
- SSDC have agreed to look at additional lighting near to the Pavilion.
- Domain name Perton.pc.co.uk cancelled with Kalidescope, no longer used
- Following discussion with SSDC, Town and Country meats will be selling fresh meat from the Pavillion Car park on Fridays during the government social distancing restrictions only. They have agreed with the Community Support Hub to donate meat packs to Corsers Court.
- Down to Earth will commence grass cutting in the play area, ensuring that they will follow government guidelines on social distancing.

- Residents are being urged to observe the restrictions when using public footpaths and bridleways especially on the land at Bradshaws. The Chairman has posted a request on Facebook.
- 2 members of Civic Centre staff have been furloughed under the Government Job Retention Scheme, the Parish Council will contribute the additional 20%. It is unknown if as a tier of local government this will be successful.
- Fishing pools are to be closed following Government advice. SSDC will be posting a message on social media and will be asking the Police to patrol the area if this becomes an issue.
- Grant applications have been submitted to Staffordshire County Council and The Community of Staffordshire towards the Community Support Hub.
