- Resident complaint regarding a group congregated in the small patch of woodland at the end of Elgin Court, Perton. They were drinking alcohol, smoking drugs and making noise. PC reported to PCSO's and the District Council who will look at measures that can be taken to limit the use of the space.
- Email received from the Environment Agency, investigation of a report of sewage pollution in the River Penk, this could be a possible misconnection in the local area from a private surface water system, possibly from the Pavilion. Emailed details to the Chairman of the Playing Fields Association, Wild About Perton and the District Council. Cllr K Elder has carried out a check of the affected area but found no evidence for raised levels of ammonia above the drain in 2 places and below the drain in 2 places. Site to be monitored.
- HMRC have refunded £631.26 as part of the Job Retention Scheme.
- The clerk has applied to South Staffordshire District Council for a reduction in Business Rates but not sure the parish council will be eligible as a precepting authority.
- Severn Trent provided the Support Huub with £2000 grant, It was agreed to donate £500 to the Kingsway Food Bank in Wombourne as they were providing food parcels for some Perton families. This removes the responsibility from the HUB. Kingsway Food Bank will provide details of the number of families supported weekly
- Staffordshire County Council – Flood Risk officer confirmed that the meeting to discuss the flooding issues in Perton will be delayed due to the current restrictions.
- Cancelled Events: advertised on facebook

  - Perton Carnival and VE Day 8th May – cancelled
- Pigeons have been found in the heating fans of the Lakeside Hall. The Caretakers will investigate when they return to the centre.
- Ash Waste have approved a credit for collections due to the centre closure, collections are suspended until further notice
- First half of the Precept has been received.
- Resident report that the River Penk at Gainsborough Drive is getting blocked with Debris. PPC reported to SSDC.
- The Management Committee have agreed to hold a virtual meeting on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May at 6pm. This will also be a trial for holding any future full council meetings if required.
