### Other matters

- PPC requested has Street Scene remove parts of cars, metal plates and lumps of wood from the A41 between the Wolverhampton boundary and the traffic lights as reported by a resident who frequently litter picks this section road. District Council have agreed to remove the debris but currently have staff shortages. They will be updating and prioritising these jobs on a daily basis and would ask we be patient whilst they work through these.

- Update DPI's forwarded to SSDC monitoring Officer. All councillors to consider if their DPI is up to date.
- Only two food parcels delivered to Perton this week from Kingsway Food Bank
- PPC has purchased floor stickers reminding civic centre users to socially distance for when the government guidelines change and we can open the centre again.
- PPC applied for discretionary rate relief from the District Council, unfortunately the current regulations do not allow for a billing authority to award discretionary relief to a precepting authority and therefore they are unable to award a business rates relief at this time.
