- The water tests for legionella have come back with the kitchen cold samples are >1000 CF/U which is the maximum reporting limit. It is recommended that the system is chlorinated to reduce bacteria levels to acceptable drinking levels at a cost of £475 + VAT
- 3 food parcels were delivered to Perton this week from the Kingsway Food Bank
- Reported to SSDC dead Muntjac deer on A41 verge just past turning to former Sandhill Day Nursery
