### Other matters

- Kingsway food bank donations. Week endings 13/06 and 20/06 the Foodbank has delivered 3 and 2 parcels to Perton respectively. That means since lockdown began 45 parcels have been delivered.
- PPC has reported that the life belts around the lake are not accessible due to overgrowth.
- PPC requested an update on the installation of 'no fishing' signs and the removal of the fishing club details.
- Clerk is striving to get information on the lift contract to enable to agree future contract.
- A large hole in Smiths Rough (off a footpath) has been reported to District Council. The land owner has been made aware of the issue.
- There are overflow issues at the pumping station caused by non biodegradable products. A new pump is currently being fitted that will deal with 'rag'
- A resident has alleged that they were assaulted on a footpath between the two St. Andrews Drive entrances, unfortunately this incident was not reported to the police.
- There continues to be fishing at the lakes. The fishing club signs have now been removed. PCSO's have been asked to patrol the area.
- Resident reported a pot hole in Severn Drive, it has already been reported to Highways and marked.
- Following discussion with the Health and safety consultants and Parish Council Chairman it was agreed to leave the play area closed until further guidance from the Government.
